APPLICATION PROCESS AND INFORMATION

The application deadline is Friday, March 30, 2012 and the 2012-13 league members will be announced in April 2012.

- The league fee is \$1,500 per team, per event (6), which does not include administration fees. (18U=\$9,000, 16U=\$9,000).
- The administration fee is \$1,500 per association and is due with application.
- Fee Schedule: \$1,500 upon acceptance, \$3,000 on or before August 31, 2012, \$4,500 due on or before October 15, 2012.
- Once a club is accepted, the initial \$1,500 payment must be received prior to being announced as a member of the PHL.
- Once a club is announced as a member of the PHL, the initial payment and administration fee is non-refundable.
- The PHL is accepting applications from associations applying for more than one age classification.
